The world of technology is either baffling, grudgingly accepted, or a natural way of life – depending on our ages and inclinations. Kathy and I depend on our children to keep us up-to-date. In fact, The *JESUS* Film Project has just introduced a new “App” that allows the user to download any language translation or version of the *JESUS* film and e-mail them to people throughout the world.

So, if you have a “smartphone” like an Android or an iPhone, this will work for you. You will be able to pass on the *JESUS* film in any of the 1,160 languages of the world. If you are able to send an e-mail, or you have a Facebook page, you are in the upper echelon of the new media generation. Even if you are “technically challenged,” like me, there is still hope for you to use this “App” (stands for Application), and give the *JESUS* film to every person you meet in their own language – Free!



The “Tech Guy”

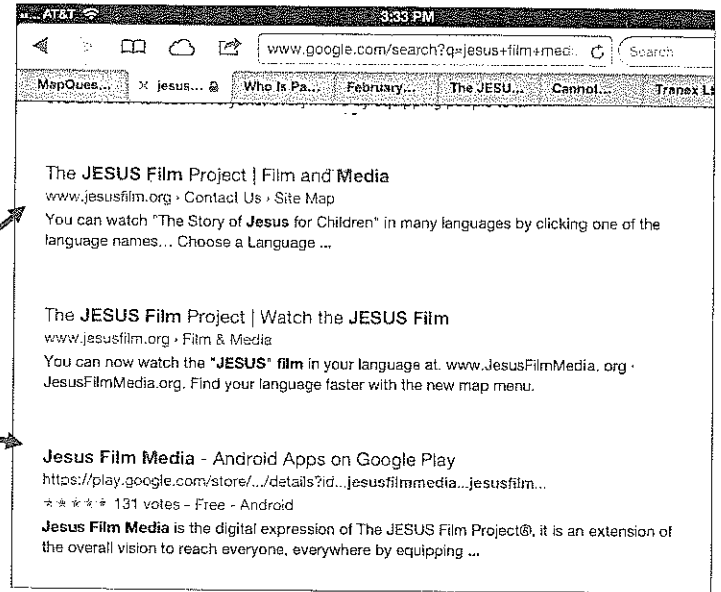
Before I tell you how it works, I want to tell you my experience in using it on my last trip. Last week I was traveling to Atlanta. I had a German-speaking taxi driver from Colombia. I asked him if he had ever seen the *JESUS* film in German. He said, “No.” When I asked him if he would like me to send him a copy of the film to his e-mail, he said, “Of course.” I let him listen to a minute or so of the film in German and then copied down his e-mail address.

When I arrived in Atlanta, my taxi drive to the hotel was from Ethiopia. I played him a little of the Amharic translation. He was elated to hear his mother-tongue language. On the trip back to the airport, my driver was from Ghana. I gave him the Twi version. He was stunned that I had a film in his language.

The world is changing rapidly. In some major cities, more than half of the people living there were born outside our country. It’s a great day to share the message and almost everyone coming to our shores would love to see a film in their own language. Let me show you how it works.

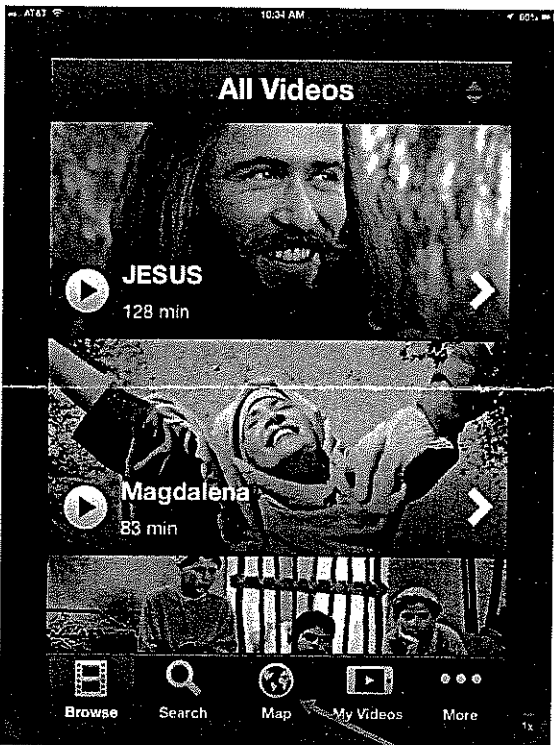
Go to the www.JesusFilmMedia.org site on your phone or iPad. Select the JESUS Film Media App for your Android or iPhone and follow the instructions to download.

When you download and open the App, the screen will look like this. As you scroll down the page, you will see that you can access:

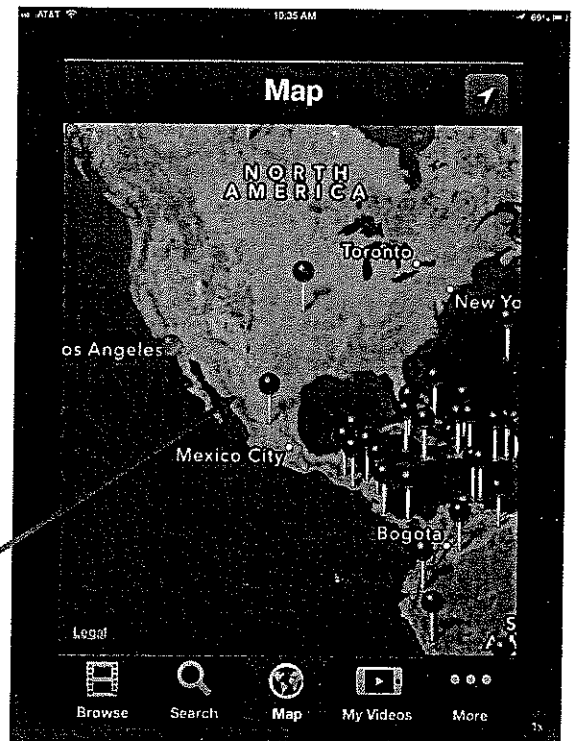
- *JESUS* – The classic film
- *Magdalena* – The new version of the *JESUS* film developed for women.
- *The Story of Jesus for Children* – A 61-minute version of the film that every child should see.
- Eleven other Short Films – I recommend “Venia” and “The Search.” These are 4-6 minute films that are great for teenagers and help to open spiritual conversations.

To send a film to someone, click on the map icon at the bottom. Start with the classic *JESUS* film and then check to see what interest there might be in other versions. Not all the film versions are available in every language – yet.

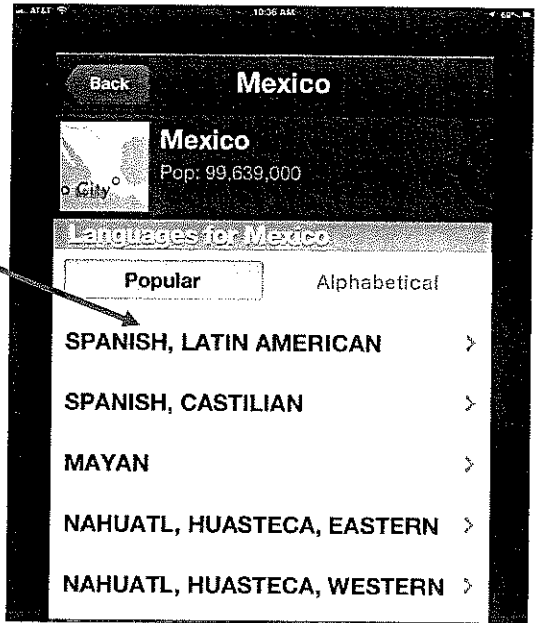
If you need to send a Spanish version to someone, simply touch the red pin in the middle of the map of Mexico.

This will bring up the various languages in Mexico.

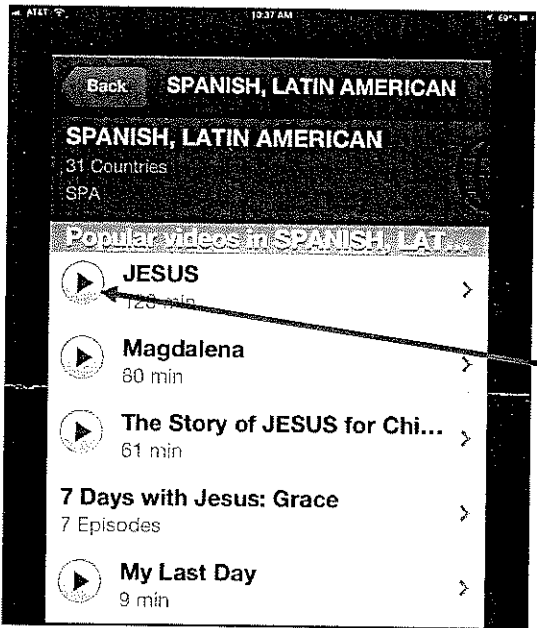
Select Spanish, *Latin American*.

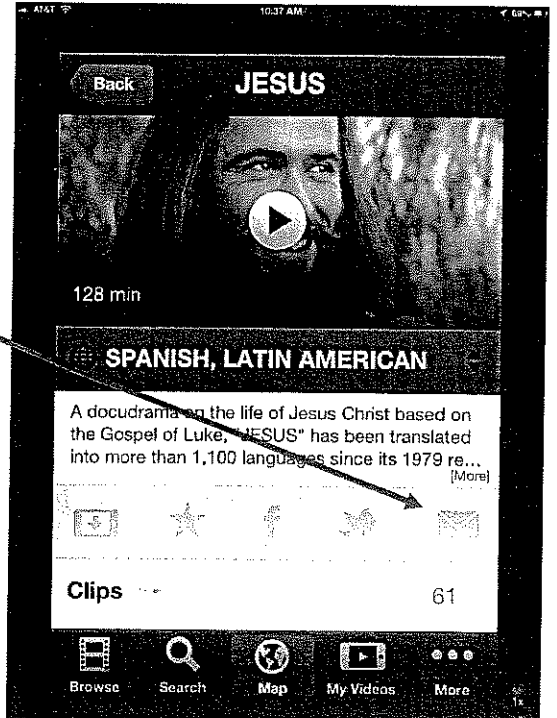
This screen will show you all the films that are available in that language.

You can then touch the button to start the film and let them hear a little bit of the movie. After you have played a small portion, simply stop the film and ask them for their e-mail.

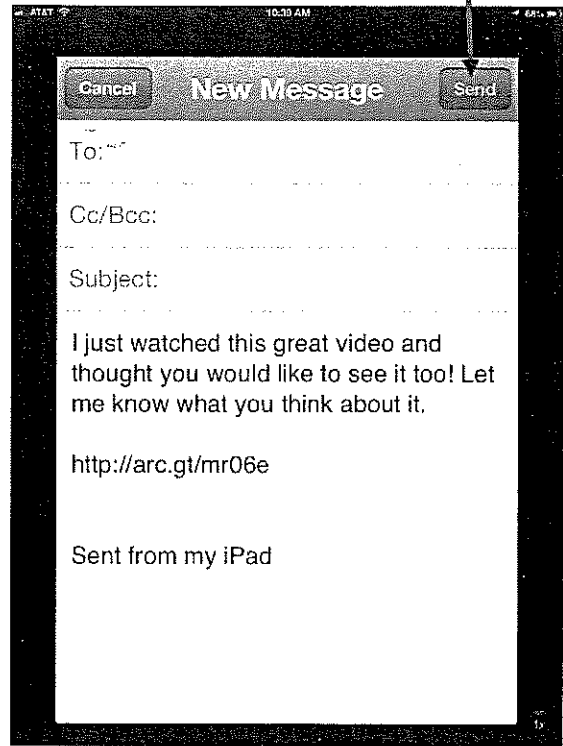
Go to the bottom of the screen and touch the envelope icon to send it to them by e-mail. You can also forward it by Facebook or Twitter, or download it.

When you click on the envelope for e-mail, this screen will appear. When you are finished typing in their e-mail address, click "send" and it will be forwarded immediately to their cell phone or iPad.

So, now you just need a little practice sending the film to a few people. Get your children or grandchildren to help. You can be missionaries together, sending the film to immigrants or foreign visitors you meet at the mall. Look for people speaking other languages and tell them you'd like to give them a film in their home language. They will love it.
